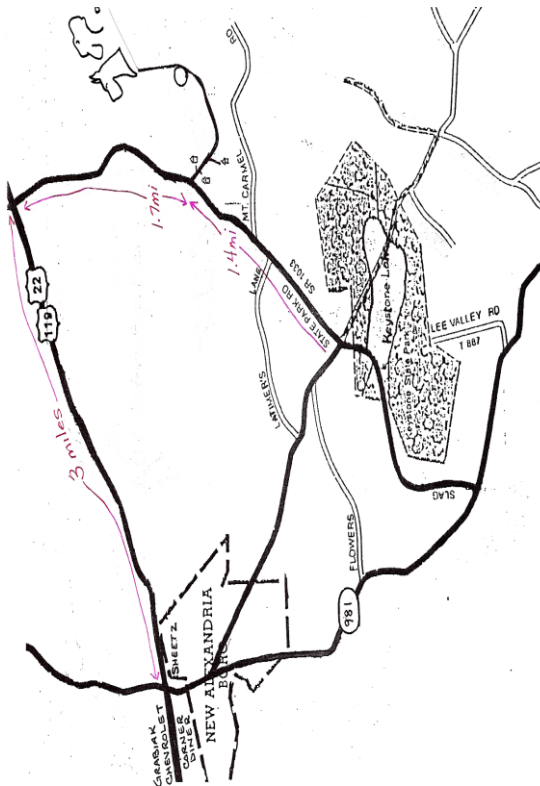


Directions to Hickory Grove: About Cathy Peters



From Route 22:

At the traffic light at Sheetz take Rt 981 South. Second left on Keystone Park Rd Go 3 miles then left onto State Park Rd. Go 1.4 mi. Right on (gravel) Rhododendron Dr. Go 1/2 mile into woods. Kennel on left.

From Route 30:

Rt 981 N passed Elks Club. Right on Slag Rd. At stop sign go straight onto State Park Rd. Go 1.4 mi. Right on Rhododendron Dr. 1/2 mi into the woods. Kennel on left.



From an early age Cathy preferred dogs to toys. As an adult she trained her own dogs to be well behaved at family functions. She also learned to handle in conformation dog shows, finishing champions for clients, and handling at the prestigious Westminster Kennel Club dog show. She handled her own dogs at trials to win working titles.

In 1995 Cathy graduated from West Virginia Canine College where she learned the details of training personal protection dogs and rehabbing aggression problems. Her real sense of satisfaction comes from the balanced approach to training she offers to keep good dogs in good homes, helping the owner to learn the skills they need to be their dog's teacher, leader, and best friend.

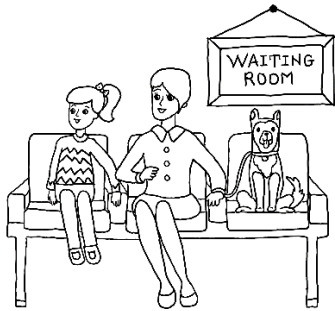

Training and Boarding



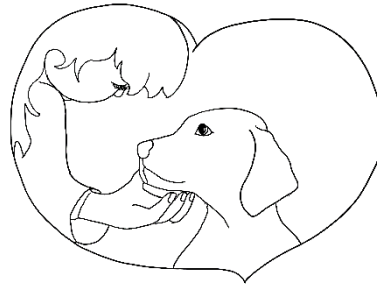
Consultation is our first meeting to explain our methods, answer your questions and develop a customized training plan.

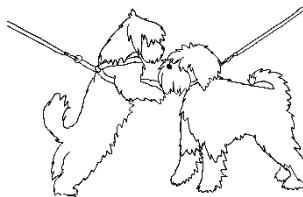
Private Lessons are the best way to begin training. Without distractions, owners learn to bond and train with their dog efficiently and quickly.
